



Further to your information request FOI/EIR 25/26-194, please find your question and our response below.

Request:

Last year ECDC ran a scheme where local people could apply for 4 small houses being built on the old Paradise Pool site and you are not running another in Kennett. I would like to understand what criteria was used when allocating the four houses in Ely. Particularly how final allocation related to the initial application form which awarded points for living in Ely, being a key worker, etc and how people who scored highly on that initial application were then eliminated from the next stage of the process.

Response:

The attached allocations policy sets out the criteria and how points are awarded – the same policy/criteria is used for all schemes (albeit the location will change depending on where the properties are).
